## **Introduction**

This document details population and household information relevant to the Paisley South West multi-member electoral ward sourced from Scotland's Census 2011, published by the National Records of Scotland in various releases since 2012. The document is split into seven sections: General Population, Equality and Human Rights, Marital and Civil Partnership Status, Economic Activity, Household Information, Transport, and Health and Care.

## Summary

- Paisley South West is situated to the South East of Renfrewshire, and shares borders with the Paisley North West, Paisley South, and Johnstone South, Elderslie and Howwood wards.
- The ward incorporates the housing areas of Brediland, Foxbar and Stanely, Gleniffer High School, and attractions such as Stanely Castle in the waters of the Stanely Reservoir and the Gleniffer Braes country park.
- Over 16,000 people live in the area, in more than 7,000 households.
- There are more females (52.49%) in the ward than males (47.51%).
- The area has a similar proportion of working-age population compared with the Renfrewshire total.
- 98% of the population are White; there is a lower than average proportion of Asian residents equating to the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest number of this group of any Renfrewshire ward and 35% of people in Paisley South West are not religious.
- Less than 1% of the population have any Gaelic skills.
- 45% of people aged 16 and over in Paisley South West are married.
- At the time of the census more working-age people were in full-time employment (41.46%) than across Renfrewshire (41.13%).
- At the time of the census the main employment industries were human health, wholesale and retail trade, and education.
- Overall qualification levels are lower than Renfrewshire, but there are more females with higher qualifications than males.
- 69% of all household spaces in Paisley South West are whole houses or bungalows and less than a third are flats or tenements. Two thirds of households own their property either outright or with a mortgage.
- A quarter of all households have two or more cars or vans.
- There are proportionally more unemployed male lone parents (41.46%) in the ward than across Renfrewshire (33.5%).
- There are proportionately more deprived households than across Renfrewshire but this difference is only in the lowest deprivation levels while there are similar proportions of households experiencing the higher levels of deprivation.
- 81% of people believe they have 'Very Good or Good Health'.
- 68% of people have no long-term health conditions.
- Approximately 10% of people provide unpaid care.

## Section One – General Population

Table 1 illustrates the total number of households, and the total number of people living in Paisley South West. There are over 7,000 households in Paisley South West, which equates to 9.08% of the total number of households in Renfrewshire. There are over 16,000 people that live in the ward, which equates to 9.38% of the Renfrewshire population.

Following on from this, Table 2 illustrates the total number of males and females in Paisley South West against the Renfrewshire totals. The picture is slightly different, with almost 53% of the ward population being female, compared with 51.91% of Renfrewshire. There is a lower than average proportion of males in the ward, with 47.51% compared with 48% across Renfrewshire.

Paisley South West has a higher than average proportion of 5 to 14 year olds than the rest of Renfrewshire, but a lower proportion of 15 to 44 year olds. The middle aged to older ward population is generally larger than the rest of Renfrewshire, with 23% aged 45 to 59 compared to 22% across Renfrewshire, and 9.54% aged 65 to 74 compared to 9.23% across Renfrewshire.

In Table 4 it can be seen that young people aged 5 to 15 make up almost 13% of the ward population compared to 12% across the local authority.

Table 5 illustrates the total working-age population of Paisley South West against the whole of Renfrewshire. Paisley South West has a slightly lower percentage of working-age people; 65% aged 16 to 64 compared to 65.59% across Renfrewshire.

In Table 6, five-year age bands of all people in Paisley South West are illustrated, separated by gender. There are more people in the 45 to 49 age band in Paisley South West than in any other age band (1,476) with almost 51% of them female. There is a higher proportion of men in Paisley South West living until the ages of 80 to 94 than there are across Renfrewshire. In every age band from age 25 onwards, there is a higher proportion of females than males in Paisley South West, which occurs 5 years later from 30 onwards across the whole of Renfrewshire. The age band with the closest split between the male and female populations in Paisley South West is 15 to 19, with 49.59% of the population male and 50.41% female. This equates to 485 males and 493 females in Paisley South West.

To summarise, there is a similar but slightly lower proportion of working-age people in Paisley South West compared with the rest of Renfrewshire, while there is also similar but slightly higher proportions of people aged under 18 and older adults than across Renfrewshire.

## Section Two – Ethnicity and Religion

Paisley South West has a diverse mix yet smaller proportion of ethnic groups compared with the whole of Renfrewshire. There is a slightly higher White and African population compared with the rest of Renfrewshire, however there is a smaller than average composition of Asian, Asian Scottish and Asian British people in the ward than there is throughout Renfrewshire. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> smallest number of this group of any Renfrewshire ward. Table 7 shows over 98% of the Paisley South West population to be white. Tables 8.1 and 8.2 develop this further, by looking at the total number of males and females across each ethnic group, broken into age bands.

## Section Three – Marital and Civil Partnership Status

Proportions of the marital status groups are similar to the whole of Renfrewshire but there are small variations. A higher proportion of people aged 16 and over in Paisley South West (45%) are married, compared to the total Renfrewshire population. Table 11 highlights that a higher percentage of people (3.64%) in Paisley South West are separated, but are still legally married or in a civil partnership, than the Renfrewshire average (3.55%). Tables 12.1 and 12.2 illustrate the total number of males and females across each category, split into age bands.

The tables show that while there is a higher proportion of married people in the ward compared with the whole of Renfrewshire, in total people in Paisley South West are more likely not to be married than married, while females are less likely than males to be married. Approximately 42% of females are married, compared with 48% of males.

The Census defines Economic Activity as “*whether or not a person aged 16 and over was working or looking for work in the week before census. Rather than a simple indicator of whether or not someone was currently in employment, it provides a measure of whether or not a person was an active participant in the labour market.*”<sup>1</sup>

Across Paisley South West, there were a higher percentage of people in employment than there was throughout Renfrewshire; 41.5% in full-time employment and 14% in part-time employment. However, there was a lower proportion of full-time students in the ward (3.42%) than the Renfrewshire average (3.82%), and a larger proportion of people in Paisley South West were unemployed (5.73%) compared with the rest of Renfrewshire. Approximately 16% of people in the ward were retired, higher than the Renfrewshire average. The ward is more economically active (69.6%) than the whole of Renfrewshire (68.7); there are more men in full-time employment than women, while there are more women in part-time employment or looking after the family at home.

Industries that employed the most people aged 16 to 74 in Paisley South West were human health and social activities, wholesale and retail trade, and education. Industries where the people of Paisley South West were under-represented compared to the Renfrewshire total were accommodation and food service activities, financial and insurance activities, agricultural, forestry and fishing, and information and communication. There are slight variations in employment proportions across Renfrewshire but generally industries in Paisley South West have similar industry employment levels. The male/female divide in industries in Renfrew North is as expected and is broadly similar in line with the divide across Renfrewshire.

Following on from industry, Table 15 indicates the occupation of all people aged 16 to 74 in Paisley South West. The most common occupation for people in Paisley South West was professional occupations, which was the most common occupation of all people in Renfrewshire. The occupation with the least number of people employed in Paisley South West was managerial or senior officials, with 7.58% of people in this occupation.

Levels of education qualifications across Paisley South West are slightly poorer than the Renfrewshire total. One-fifth of people in the ward have achieved a Degree, Masters or PhD compared with 23% of the Renfrewshire population, while there are more people with no qualifications in Paisley South than there are throughout Renfrewshire.

## Section Five – Household Information

The most common type of household in Paisley South West is one person households, with almost 35% of all households in the ward falling into this category. However, this is lower than the Renfrewshire equivalent of 38.6%. As can also be seen from the table, there are a higher proportion of married couple households with no dependent children within the ward than there are throughout Renfrewshire, and also a higher percentage of lone parent households.

Following on from Table 17, Table 18 illustrates that there are more households that are owned in Paisley South West than as an average across Renfrewshire. There are also a higher percentage of households in Paisley South West (19.91%) that are rented from Renfrewshire Council compared to the Renfrewshire average (15.71%). However, the proportion of the whole rental sector is lower in Paisley South West than across the whole of Renfrewshire because of lower proportions of other social rented and private rental. It is likely that this is as a result of the spread of housing associations throughout Renfrewshire, concentrated out with the ward.

## Section Six - Transport

The most common method of transport used by working age people of Paisley South West and across the whole of Renfrewshire is by driving a car or van. There are a higher proportion of people in Paisley South West that travel to work by bus. It is less likely that someone from Paisley South West will walk to work compared to the Renfrewshire average.

Leading on from this, Table 25.2 illustrates the level of health of all people in Paisley South West, by their age and ethnic group. There are 12 people of Caribbean or Black origin, all of whom have ‘very good or good health’, while four out of 107 Asian people have ‘bad or very bad health’.
