Glasgow Airport Investment Area

The Glasgow Airport Investment Area project is a £51.39million investment; generating business growth, attracting inward investment, supporting the airport's growth and underlining Renfrewshire's pivotal role in the City Region's economy. The site adds to an established network of thriving business locations and a growing number of quality residential riverside developments.

The project is designed to link up the Glasgow Airport, Westway and Inchinnan business parks. It will enhance connectivity between these sites and Paisley with improved roads, cycle routes and footpaths. In an attractive and sustainable business environment, companies and employees will enjoy high quality access to an integrated transport network and complimentary facilities at the nearby university and college.

Connectivity and flexibility

Renfrewshire is home to Glasgow Airport from which 30 airlines fly nearly 9million people to and from more than 130 destinations.

Scotland's fourth busiest rail station, Paisley Gilmour Street, sees over 4million passengers per annum. By 2024, Paisley Gilmour Street and Glasgow Airport will be linked directly by rail.









Industry and Innovation

Home to both innovative high growth start-ups and international companies, Renfrewshire offers a broad range of properties, sites and developments for businesses on the move. For generations, Renfrewshire has enjoyed a successful dialogue with the world, based on industry, innovation and a legacy in the design and production of global textiles.

Eight miles from Glasgow city centre and five minutes from Paisley town centre, the Glasgow Airport Investment Area is a 60 Ha, internationally connected, greenfield site on the banks of the White Cart River.

This modern business location integrates with the airport, connects directly to Scotland's motorway network and is 12 minutes from Glasgow city centre.

The location's strategic importance is underlined by the £51million City Deal investment in its infrastructure to optimise its air, sea and land connections.



Renfrewshire's largest town, Paisley, is bidding to be the UK City of Culture in 2021. This will see a year-long programme of major events, that will put the area in the international spotlight.

A partnership between Renfrewshire Council, the cultural and creative community, businesses and other key bodies is preparing a bid which will promote Paisley to the world. The economic and social impact of these ambitions will be felt throughout the area.







City Deal Renfrewshire



The Glasgow Airport Investment Area, on which work will start in 2017, will support business growth with a £51million spend on roads, paths, cycle ways and a bridge to join up existing land, sea and air connections.

The Clyde Waterfront and Renfrew Riverside project will build a bridge over the Clyde; linking western Glasgow with Renfrew, improving road connections throughout the area and supporting industrial, commercial and social development in Renfrewshire. This £78million investment will be completed in 2020.

The Airport Access Project plans a rail link between Glasgow Airport and Glasgow city centre. This will support the Airport's continuing success and help to develop the Investment Area's connectivity. This new rail link will be built by 2024.
