

CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982
APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE
PROPOSED FAIRGROUND AND ICE RINK AT CENOTAPH, GILMOUR STREET,
COUNTY SQUARE, COUNTY PLACE, HIGH STREET, PAISLEY

NOTICE is hereby given that an application for a public entertainment licence has been submitted to Renfrewshire Council by **Lochview Theme Park (Scotland) Ltd** in respect of a **Fairground** which falls under the category of **Fairground and Large Fete (tented accommodation for public)** at **Cenotaph, Gilmour Street, County Square, County Place, High Street, Paisley**. The proposed times of operation are **28 November 2024 to 28 December 2024 from 10.00am until 10.00pm every day (closed Christmas Day)**.

Any objection or representation relating to the application shall be entertained by the licensing authority if, but only if, the objection or representation-

- (a) is in writing;
- (b) specifies the grounds of the objection or, as the case may be, the nature of the representation;
- (c) specifies the name and address of the person making it;
- (d) is signed by him or on his behalf (the Council is now able to accept an objection electronically for this type of application, with an electronic signature, as above, emailed into licensingadmin@renfrewshire.gov.uk; and
- (e) was made to them by 1 November 2024.

It shall be competent for a licensing authority to entertain an objection or representation received by them before they take a final decision upon the application if they are satisfied that there is sufficient reason why it was not made in the time required as in accordance with the above.

An objection or representation shall be made if it is delivered by hand within the timescale stated above or posted (by registered or recorded delivery post) so that in the normal course of post it might be expected to be delivered to the licensing authority within that timescale.
